FEEDBACK

- Define and apply criteria (e.g. Bromme/Rambow)
 - gut response (how did this make me feel?) plus reflection
- Always start with positive aspects
 - "It was a very lively presentation, but sometimes I had difficulty hearing you, because you were facing away from the audience."
- Constructive criticism
 - "There was a lot of dense information. I would have welcomed a question round after 5 minutes"
- Subject-centered language: it's your perception!
 - Not: "the presentation made no sense"
 - But: "I did not get the point of the presentation"
 - Plus reasons "....because I couldn't identify a clear thesis"
- Discuss the performance in question, not the person
 - Avoid ad hominen fallacies (I don't accept your argument becauseof who you are)
 - Avoid generalizations: "You're no good at presenting."
